

# FLAG Flag Football 2008 Playoff Schedule

Following is the playoff schedule. A few relevant notes:

- The top two seeds will each receive a first round bye while the remaining 12 seeds will compete to advance to the quarterfinals.
- While the standings are posted by division, teams will be seeded 1 through 14. Tie breaker procedures follow.
- For all playoff games, the higher seeded teams elect the field of play.

10:15 am

G3 – Seed 3 v Seed 14

G4 – Seed 4 v Seed 13

G5 – Seed 5 v Seed 12

G6 – Seed 6 v Seed 11

## **Quarterfinals – 11:30 am**

G7 – Seed 1 v winner G2

G8 – Seed 2 v winner G1

G9 – Winner G3 v winner G6

G10 – Winner G4 v winner G5

## **Semifinals – 12:45 pm**

G11 – Winner G7 v winner G10

G12 – Winner G8 v winner G9

## **Super Fabulous Bowl – 2:00 pm**

G13 – Winner G11 v Winner G12

## **Tie-breaker procedures – 2008 playoffs:**

If two teams are tied:

- the tie will be broken based on head-to-head competition
- if still tied, the tie will be broken based on forfeits – the team with the fewer number of forfeits earns the higher seed
- if still tied, average points allowed will be used to break the tie
- if still tied, the tie will be broken by drawing team names from a hat

If three or more teams are tied:

- the tie will be broken based on head-to-head-to-head (etc) competition
- if one or more teams are eliminated by the first tie-breaker, then head-to-head competition will break the tie among the remaining teams
- if still tied, the tie will be broken based on forfeits – the team with the fewer number of forfeits earns the higher seed
- if still tied, average points allowed will be used to break the tie
- if still tied, the tie will be broken by drawing team names from a hat
